

KEEP KIDS AWAY FROM TRACTORS

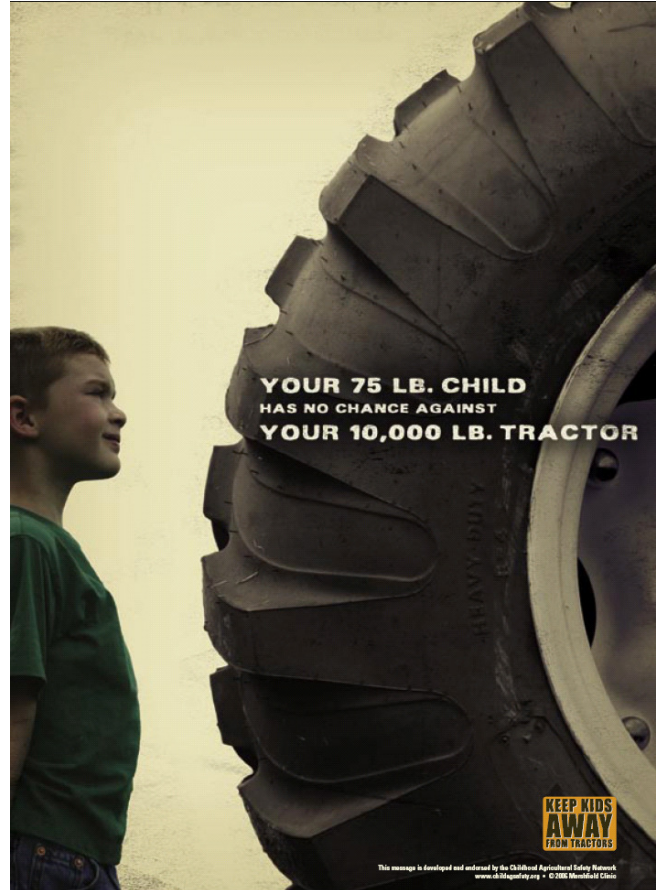


THE TRACTOR IS NOT THE PLACE FOR
